Thank you for your interest in Nova Southeastern University's (NSU) Master of Accounting (MACC) program. Enrollment in the Master of Accounting program can assist you in preparing for and passing the Certified Public Accounting (CPA) license exam. Because the MACC program can assist you in obtaining professional licensure, NSU is required by law to disclose to you specific state license requirements. In particular, NSU must disclose whether (1) the program does meet state educational requirements for professional licensure, (2) does not meet state educational requirements for professional licensure.

The attached professional licensure disclosure notification is designed to provide the aforementioned detail for all 50 states in the U.S., the District of Columbia, and U.S. protectorates. Section (1) of the disclosure is for those who have earned a bachelor's degree in accounting or a business-related field. Section (2) is for those who have earned a bachelor's degree that is not in accounting or a business-related field.

Upon review, should you find you reside and/or wish to obtain licensure in a state where the program does not meet state educational requirements or it cannot be confirmed if the program does so, do not be discouraged. It is possible a review of your bachelor's degree coursework will eliminate any potential concerns for state licensure requirements. Dr. Kim will review your bachelor's degree coursework and provide you greater detail as you further consider the program.
